Kaiser Permanente Occupational Health Services are available to all employees, not just our members.

If you have an emergency medical condition, call 911 or go to the nearest hospital.

An emergency medical condition is any of the following:

- A medical condition that manifests itself by acute symptoms of sufficient severity (including severe pain) such that you could reasonably expect the absence of immediate medical attention to result in serious jeopardy to your health or body functions or organs;
- Active labor when there isn't enough time for safe transfer to a Plan hospital (or designated hospital) before delivery, or if transfer poses a threat to your (or your unborn child's) health and safety;
- A mental disorder that manifests itself by acute symptoms of sufficient severity such that either you are an immediate danger to yourself or others, or you are not immediately able to provide for, or use, food, shelter, or clothing, due to the mental disorder.

In case of a nonemergency work-related injury or illness, follow two simple steps:

1. Inform your supervisor of your work-related injury or illness as soon as possible.
2. Call the Kaiser On-the-Job[®] Dedicated Occupational Health Center nearest you. To locate your nearest KOJ center, call toll free 1-888-KOJ-WORK (1-888-565-9675).

If you have predesignated a provider as your occupational health physician, please follow the appropriate guidelines for accessing nonemergency, work-related injury care.

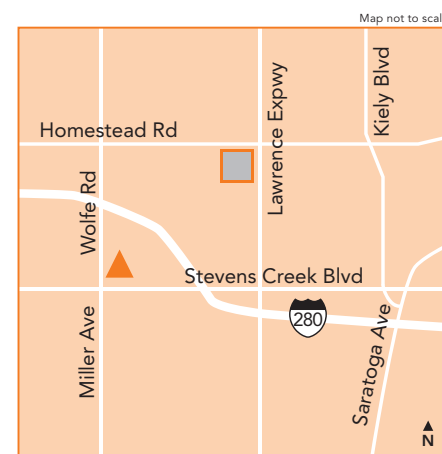

Se ofrecen los Servicios para la Salud Ocupacional de Kaiser Permanente a todos los empleados, no sólo a nuestros miembros.

Si tiene un problema médico de emergencia, llame al 911 o vaya al hospital más cercano.

Éstas son las condiciones que se consideran como problemas médicos de emergencia:

- Un problema médico que se manifieste con síntomas agudos de tal gravedad (incluido el dolor intenso) que usted crea, dentro de lo razonable, que el no recibir atención médica de inmediato pueda poner en peligro grave su salud o sus funciones corporales o los órganos.
- Cuando se encuentre en trabajo activo de parto y no se cuente con tiempo suficiente para trasladarla de manera segura a un hospital del Plan (u hospital designado) antes del parto, o cuando dicho traslado represente una amenaza para la salud y seguridad de usted (de su bebé aún no nacido).
- Un trastorno mental que se manifieste con síntomas agudos de tal gravedad que usted represente un peligro inmediato para sí mismo o terceros, o bien que usted no pueda inmediatamente proveer ni utilizar alimentos, vivienda o ropa como resultado del trastorno mental.

En caso de una lesión o enfermedad relacionada con el trabajo que no sea de emergencia, siga estos dos sencillos pasos:

1. Informe lo más pronto posible a su supervisor sobre la lesión o enfermedad relacionada con el trabajo.
2. Llame al Centro Dedicado a Servicios para la Salud Ocupacional de Kaiser On-the-Job® más cercano. Para ubicar su centro KOJ más cercano, llame al número sin costo 1-888-565-9675 (1-888-KOJ-WORK).

Si tiene un proveedor previamente designado como su médico para la salud ocupacional, por favor siga las pautas correspondientes para obtener acceso a los servicios de atención de lesiones relacionadas con el trabajo que no sean de emergencia.
